Meet Your Neighbors Marcelo Defreitas and Scott Smith



What Sonoma neighborhood can point to having had three of its own selected to be Sonoma's Alcalde in the past seven years? (The Alcalde is the honorary mayor of Sonoma for a one year term, selected—after a rigorous process—by the mayor to recognize outstanding contributions to the Sonoma community.) The current Alcalde is Marcelo Defreitas, the Board President of La Luz Center and non-profit event producer extraordinaire, the spouse of financial services (venture capital, merchant banking and wealth management) entrepreneur and author Scott Smith. Marcelo and Scott, who have been together for 30 years and married for 10, purchased their magical piece of Diamond A heaven (having been shown it by our very own Leo Merle) more than 20 years ago, and they have been living in their showplace home on the property for 12 years. They share their land with 9 peacocks, 2 horses, 100 chickens, two swan, about 30 "rescue" parrots, three very

Scott has a BA in philosophy and a law degree; Marcelo was in a joint USF/Academy of Art program and graduated with a degree in graphic design. Yes, he surely could. He became very interested in La Luz' mission, and he became increasingly involved and has served as its Board president for three years; he's been on the Board for nine years. He has also helped arrange events for many non-profits over the years, including the 100th birthday of Jack London, though he's thinking about dialing those activities back a bit.

Hoping to raise a child, they entered into an adoption agreement with a young woman, but when her family saw the baby, she changed her mind. Then they tried to adopt a Rwandan baby but were not able to. So they pour their energies into their animals, their busy lives and each other.

As usual, I asked them a few questions:

Favorite Sonoma Restaurant? Both: EDK.

Famous People You've Met? Marcelo: Obama and Oprah, at one of Obama's initial fundraisers. Scott: great-uncle Upton Sinclair and Madonna and Gwen Stefani who invested in one of Scott's businesses.

Favorite Vacation Spot? It wouldn't be a bad gig to be their travel agent. They both love St. Bart's, Venice, Rio and Thailand. Scott would love to visit Kashmir and Marcelo is looking forward to a safari. There is no other place that Marcelo would want to live, but Scott thinks he could like the island life in the Caribbean (though only if he had to live somewhere else).

Favorite Sonoma Activity: Both: the Fourth of July parade. Although the Alcalde generally waves to the crowd separately, Marcelo just marched with the La Luz delegation.

What do you worry about? Marcelo: Our politics of divisiveness; Scott: Trump. Early Bird/Night Owl: Both are (very) early birds. Scott is at the Sonoma market when it opens and then at the golf club when it opens as well. He's home in time

for breakfast, often eggs fresh from the coop. (Editor's note: the eggs really are amazing!)

What makes you get up in the morning?: Marcelo: Being able to make a better day for others; Scott: joy and curiosity..

Guilty Pleasure: Marcelo: a good martini; Scott: going wild in a casino with \$500.
