Always working in coordination with reservoir engineers, Bill's work was focused at the reservoir scale - safely and economically developing discovered oil and gas accumulations by determining optimal reservoir depletion plans using drilling of new wells as well as managing existing wellbores.

Bill is adept at reservoir characterization especially the geologic description of the reservoirs to be or under development. Much of this expertise with hydrocarbon reservoirs should be transferrable to our Diamond A aquifers.
